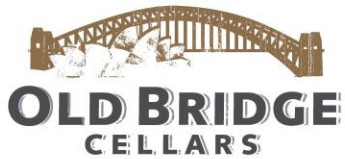

This Panel suggested pairing this Semillon with swordfish kabobs and a spring vegetable risotto.”
