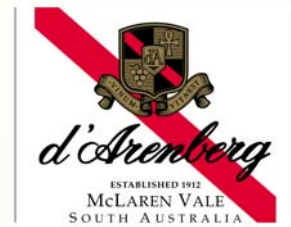




2015 d'ARENBERG THE WILD PIXIE Review Summary
