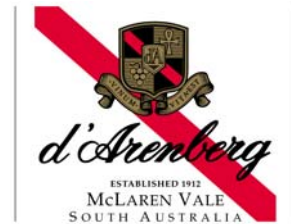


2017 d'ARENBERG THE BONSAI VINE
