

Old Bridge Cellars imports, produces and markets wines from a handful of fiercely independent wineries in the world's leading wine regions.

#### MISSION:

We see as our mission the championing of a select group of uncompromising winemakers who give everything in their pursuit of truly distinctive, regionally defined styles that sit comfortably with the world's best. Our parameters are, simply, that the wineries we represent remain true to their regions and true to themselves.

#### NIIR PORTFOLIO.

Our wine cellar, while anchored in Australia, boasts 244 different wines from 15 applauded winemaking regions across the globe. Our 28 winemakers travel home to one of six countries (AU, CL, FR, IT, NZ, USA), so from Hunter Valley Semillon to Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, we have it covered.

### HERITAGE ESTATES:

ALL of our wineries are independently owned, one in three are family owned and operated, and one in four are multi-generational.

### GREEN GROWERS:

One in five of our wineries are classified as either organic or biodynamic in their practices, with many more in conversion, and we have 24 wines that are produced to these standards.
