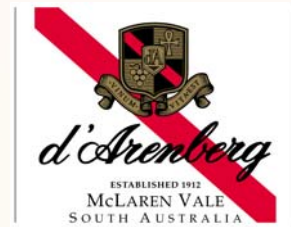


2007 d'ARENBERG THE LOVE GRASS

Review Summary



89 pts “Deep ruby with a bright rim. Spicy dark berry, cherry-cola, licorice and flowers on the nose, lifted by a peppery top note. Pliant and rich but primary, offering sweet red and dark berry flavors and gentle tannins. Building notes of cracked pepper and licorice cling to the nicely persistent, sweet finish. This is drinking well now.”

87+ pts “Purple-colored, it reveals aromas of spice box, violets, blueberry, and game. Quite structured on the palate, it is not as open and up-front as recent vintages. A bit lean and sinewy, it should be consumed near term while the fruit balances the wine’s frame.”

85 pts “This is 85% Shiraz, with the balance being Petit Verdot, Viognier, Tinta Cão, Grenache, Tempranillo and Mourvèdre. The result is a pleasant, slightly woody wine, with blackberry, cola and cedar aromas and flavors. Tart and slightly astringent on the finish, so it will do well paired with fattier cuts of red meat.”
