**92 pts** “A 65/35% blend that is delightfully crisp and crunchy, the undertow of mineral acidity running below the more sedate guava and gooseberry flavors, a twist of Meyer lemon on the finish the cream on the cake.”

**91 pts – BEST BUY** “This blend of Sauvignon Blanc (65 percent) and Semillon shows some reduction in its tart pear flavors, their greenness opening to lime leaf, white flowers and poire Williams as it develops with air. The high acidity makes it a wine for shellfish, whether prawns or crab. Decant it.”

**89 pts** “Light yellow. Lively, focused and spicy on the nose, displaying scents of lime zest, green apple, jalapeno and fresh-cut grass. Dry and taut on the palate, offering zesty citrus and orchard fruit flavors and a hint of anise that builds with air. The jalapeno note comes back on the finish, which shows good clarity and firm grip. This wine was raised in a combination of stainless steel and used oak casks.”
