A TRIBUTE TO A MARGARET RIVER PIONEER: Diana Madeline Cullen will be remembered as one of the Australian wine industry's most remarkable women. Responsible for crafting the Cullen wines from 1981, Di handed the reins to her daughter, Vanya, in 1989, who was also awarded Australian Wine magazine's highly-esteemed "Australian Winemaker of the Year" award in 2000. Vanya has transformed the family business into one of Australia's best boutique wineries and most environmentally sustainable vineyards. She's a pioneer of biodynamic grape-growing, an award-winning winemaker, and Halliday Wine Companion's "Viticulturist of the Year" 2022.

WINEMAKING: Vines were planted in 1971 on ancient gravelly granite soils producing a wine of great quality, elegance, perfume and balance. Harvested on predominately Fruit days with one harvest occurring on a Full Moon perigee with a supporting fruit trine. Skin contact time ranged from 10-29 days before being gently basket pressed to barrel. All Cullen wines are certified biodynamic with no additions.

TASTING NOTES: Cabernet Sauvignon from certified biodynamic, carbon negative fruit. This has created a natural wine with elegance, balance and power. A very complex nose with fresh notes of violets, blueberries and forest. The palate has a striking sense of power and purity with layers of blackcurrant, black tea and sage. Impeccable poise.
