87 pts “The white wines begin with the 2006 The Stump Jump White, a blend of 63% Riesling, 16% Sauvignon Blanc, and the balance Marsanne and Roussanne. It exhibits a fragrant nose of mineral, spring flowers, honeysuckle, and citrus. Just off-dry, it is tasty, clean, refreshing, and a notable value. Drink it over the next 12-18 months.”
