Jun. 08, 2013 FRISK Riesling Victoria-South Australia Prickly 2012 (85 points, \$11)

Soft, with a light fizz to the pear and floral flavors. Drink now. 15,000 cases imported. —*Harvey Steiman*

Jun. 08, 2013 FATTORIA SAN FABBIANO Chianti Conti Borghini Baldovinetti 2011 (88 points, \$18)

This red delivers richness and bright cherry, earth and bitter almond flavors, backed by a firm structure. Delivers purity, muscle and grip. Best from 2015 through 2022. 16,600 cases made. —*Bruce Sanderson*

Jun. 08, 2013 JEAN CHARTRON Bâtard-Montrachet 2010 (97 points, \$180)

An unctuous, creamy white, packed with apricot, peach, citrus, floral and spice aromas and flavors. An underlying mineral element leaves a savory impression on the finish, accompanied by notes of spice and honey. Balanced, broad-shouldered and impressive. Best from 2015 through 2030. 100 cases made. —*Bruce Sanderson*
