88-90 pts "Medium to deep garnet-purple colored, it opens with notes of crushed red and black cherries, warm redcurrants and black raspberries with wafts of garrigue, Provence herbs, underbrush and tar. The medium-bodied palate has loads of vibrant, crunchy red and black fruit with a frame of soft, rounded tannins and loads of freshness, finishing long with an herbal lift."

The result is a lovely, sappy, extremely inviting second wine that's easy to enjoy. The focus is on the red cherry and raspberry fruits, with touches of smoked cedar and some lovely rose petal aromatics. No need to wait too long to enjoy this. Yields were down around 15%."
