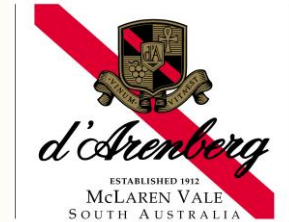




2011 d'ARENBERG THE FRUIT BAT
