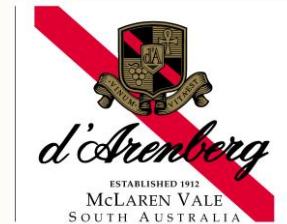




2013 d'ARENBERG THE BROKEN FISHPLATE
