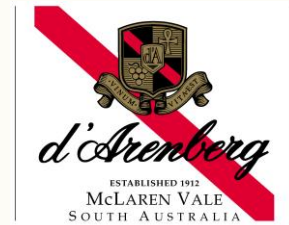




## 2012 d'ARENBERG THE STUMP JUMP RED

Juicy and focused on the palate, showing good depth and energy to its bitter cherry and dark berry flavors. Dusty tannins shape the finish, which shows good cut and subtle spicy persistence.”
