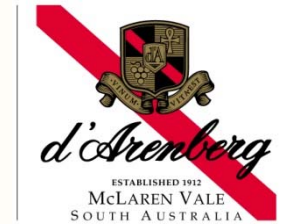




2014 d'ARENBERG THE STUMP JUMP SAUVIGNON BLANC

In a silky, lithe, fruit-driven style, finishing with a subtle floral element.”
