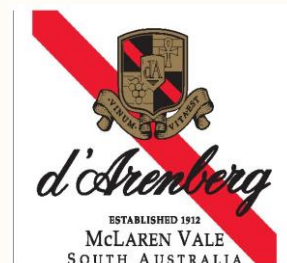




2011 d'ARENBERG THE DERELICT VINEYARD

91 pts “Bright strawberry and black tar scents fill this wine’s light structure, the tannins tense and grouchy with stems. The fruit is on the tart side of ripe, with mushroom notes adding depth. Let its spicy side develop in a decanter before serving with roast turkey.”
