93 pts “Bright red. A complex, highly perfumed bouquet evokes fresh red berries, Asian spices and potpourri, and a hint of rhubarb emerges with aeration. Juicy raspberry and bitter cherry flavors stretch out and become sweeter and deeper on the back half. Shows excellent clarity and fruity thrust on the persistent finish, which is framed by harmonious tannins that fold smoothly into the juicy fruit.”
