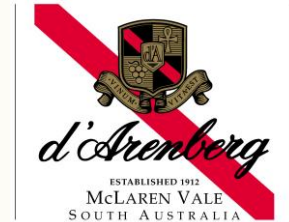


## 2015 d'ARENBERG THE BROKEN FISHPLATE
