95 pts “Hand-picked, basket-pressed, matured for 18 months in French hogsheads. It’s unusually richly endowed with juicy blackcurrant fruit from the often reticent Clare Valley in giving cabernet permission to speak. Moreover it doesn’t front-end load the wine with tannins.”

The medium-bodied palate delivers a great intensity of black fruit and cedary flavors supported by firm, grainy tannins and a lively backbone, finishing with hints of dried herbs.”
