Review Summary

93 pts "Flow. Some wines just have it. This wine combines sweetness and savoriness to good effect, and it manages to do so as one continuous stream. Balance, ripeness, a low level of oak and tannin well-seated in the fruit; all work in the wine's favor."

92 pts "It sees both French and American oak but all of it is old and to be honest, there's little evidence of oak flavor here. This is a good wine. I tasted through a number of d'Arenberg wines today and this was the one I pulled from the line-up. It's sweet-fruited, sure, but it's well balanced and has just enough savory input to keep it interesting, and moreish. Balance is the key, and it's in the wine's favor. It has depth but the drinkability factor here is high."
