Review Summary



91 pts “Earthy, mulchy savory hints over raspberry and red cherry fruit and a dusting of baking spices, enlivened by bright acidity. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered. This is kept sappy and vital thanks to 15% of whole bunch fruit, gentle foot treading and basket pressing, and light oaking in older French oak barriques. Named after the foxes that usefully crop thin the vines while eating the low-hanging grapes – and then fertilize the soil afterwards. Winemaker Chester Osborn says he always finds a ‘funky’ note in the wine – whether from the foxes or not – that adds complexity to the expressive red fruit.”
