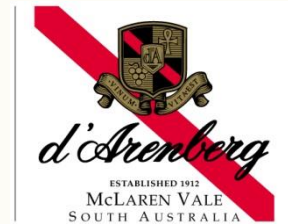


2016 d'ARENBERG THE NOBLE WRINKLED RIESLING

92 pts “Not produced every year, the 2016 The Noble Wrinkled Riesling boasts beautiful aromas of candied pineapple, honey and botrytis. Medium to full-bodied, it’s very sweet, even a bit cloying, despite having ample acidity. Barley sugar notes linger on the long finish.”
