You could think of it in the context of white Burgundy and pair it with blanquette de veau. Or you could consider it a spicy coastal white and serve it with squid stuffed with sausage. Either way, or just on its own, this is delicious. Iain Riggs makes it from a vineyard on the flats that often goes to Brokenwood’s top semillon, ILR Reserve.”
