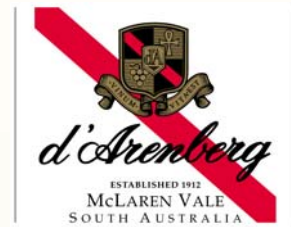




2015 d'ARENBERG THE FOOTBOLT Review Summary

90 pts “If it weren't for the savory undercurrent of black olives running through it, you might be forgiven for mistaking d'Arenberg's 2015 The Footbolt Shiraz for a vanilla-laced boysenberry pie. That's an exaggeration, but this medium to full-bodied effort does have copious amounts of mixed berry fruit, plentiful fine-grained tannins and a dry, hearty finish. It's one of my favorite vintages of this wine to date.”
