92 pts “Like others in this historic producer's range, this wine speaks softly of its people and place without feeling forced into a style or trend. It's a vibrant strawberry color, and the nose is a generously filled bowl of fresh cherries and strawberries, the stalks still on. Gentle spice and mineral nuances are present, too. Medium in weight, the silky palate comes with an almost surprising burst of acidity, considering the gentleness of the nose. A little bottle age has settled this into a lovely place.”
