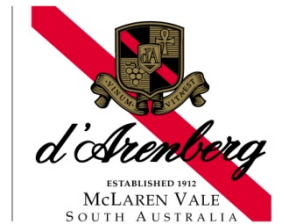


## 2019 d'ARENBERG THE DRY DAM
