90-92 pts “A barrel sample composed of 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11.5% Cabernet Franc, 8.5% Merlot and 3% Petit Verdot, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon reveals a very deep garnet-purple color with cedar and spice notes over a core of crushed blackberries, cassis and warm mulberries with touches of Chinese five spice and bay leaves, plus a hint of dried leaves. Medium to full-bodied with plenty of poise and finesse in the mouth, it features a fine-grained backbone and plenty of freshness with a lovely herbal lift on the finish.”
