

2017 GREG NORMAN ESTATES SANTA BARBARA CHARDONNAY



REGION: Santa Barbara County, California
VARIETALS: Chardonnay
MATURATION: Seasoned French oak and stainless steel
ANALYSIS: 14.2% alc/vol | 5.6 g/L TA | 3.51 pH

REGION: Santa Barbara County enjoys a long growing season, perfect for the development of concentrated and balanced fruit. The coastal climate is key - it is just warm enough that the grapes fully ripen, yet not too hot or cold that undesired characters appear. The well-draining, yet nutrient-deprived, sandstone and limestone soils force the vines to struggle for growth thereby producing berries packed with flavor intensity. A majority of the fruit for this wine was sourced from the Cat Canyon, which through its higher elevation and larger diurnal shifts in temperature, produces grapes with generous acidity and lovely tropical fruit flavors.

WINEMAKING: The whole clusters were harvested in the early morning and were immediately pressed and transferred to stainless steel tanks for fermentation. The ferments took place at cool temperatures to preserve the Chardonnay aromatics and fresh flavor profile. The wine was then racked off its lees and a portion was transferred to seasoned French oak barrels where it matured until final blending and bottling.

TASTING NOTES: The 2017 Santa Barbara Chardonnay has classic aromas of fresh lemon, pineapple and ripe stone fruit. The approachable palate reveals layers of tropical fruit, crisp apple and lemon meringue flavors that are balanced by a refreshing line of acidity through the long-lasting finish.
