

## 2018 CULLEN CABERNET SAUVIGNON MERLOT

### Review Summary



**95 pts** “62% cabernet sauvignon, 37% merlot, 1% cabernet franc. Matured in French oak (25% new) for an average of 6 months. A lifted, quite fragrant bouquet, with aromas of bay leaf, fresh green herbs, red berry fruits and cedar. A finely balanced medium-bodied palate, silky and supple with ripe but restrained flavours interwoven with very fine tannin. Poised and precise.”

**93 pts** “This Cab-dominant blend, from one of Margaret River’s founding wineries, encompasses the essence of the region. Brambly fruit mingles with notes of tomato stem, tobacco leaf, black olive and menthol, supported by polished, cherry cola-like oak. The palate is medium bodied, while the crunchy, vibrant fruit is tempered by taut, sappy, textural tannins.”

Black tea, eucalyptus and clary sage notes linger. The focus, tightness and complexity suggest a good candidate for cellaring. Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.”

Boasting herb-laced, cassis aromas, it’s medium to full-bodied, silky and elegant but slightly lacking concentration and length.”
