91 pts/VERY GOOD+ "This ruby colored Pinot Noir opens with a pomegranate bouquet with hints of plum, cumin and cola. On the palate, this wine is medium plus bodied, balanced and rich. The flavor profile is a tart plum, smoky oak and graphite blend with hints of dark chocolate and cherry. The finish is dry and its flavors and medium tannins linger for a while. The Panel suggested pairing this wine with osso buco or grilled shrimp."
