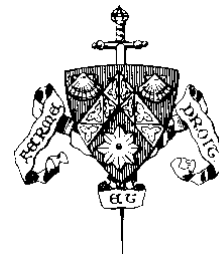


2017 YERINGBERG SHIRAZ

Review Summary



94 pts “Medium to full red with a tint of purple, a lighter colour for shiraz, and the aroma has lots of cool-grown pepper, clove, garden mint and manifold other spices. The wine is intense and elegant, yet full-bodied, with a lot of licorice and pepper touches that endure on the palate and aftertaste. Lively, with fresh acidity and energy plus. A little ageing could mellow this to advantage. It’s very young and has a bright future.”
