On the nose there is a brief bit of petrol, followed by delicious apple, beeswax, white peach and white florals. On the palate there is bright medium-plus acidity, a medium body, good balance, a wonderful very round and slightly creamy mouthfeel and nice complexity. I detected loads of flavors including pear, lemon curd, apple sauce, peach pit, minerality and mild oak. The persistent finish was dry and spicy. I would serve this impressive white blend with a roast lemon garlic chicken.”
