94 pts “From a small, cool-climate region north of Melbourne, this burnished gold-hued wine opens in aromas of lemon oil and candied ginger alongside melted butter, toffee, mushroom and mineral streaks. The palate is dry and rich but not unctuous thanks to lively acidity and a gingery bite. The finish is seemingly endless.”

This is as reliant on its waxy grip for focus and poise, as it is on its palpably natural acidity. A delicious, understated riesling. Dry. Germanic. Relaxed.”

89 pts “Darker in hue than most Australian Rieslings (and also the rare specimen under cork), the 2018 Georgia's Paddock Riesling offers up scents of Earl Grey tea (bergamot) and hints of peach and crushed stone. It's medium-bodied and streamlined on the palate, with ample weight and concentration but not much in the way of extra flesh, finishing tart and citrusy.”
