92 pts "THE SMART BUY Classic lifted, pungent aromas of freshly cut grass and herbs, with an exotic lemongrass twist. These follow through on the lively palate, joined by mouthwatering lemon, lime and grapefruit with a pop of pea pod. A barrel-fermented and lees-aged component (30%) and splash of Semillon (7%) enhances structure and texture, with talc and asparagus nuances. Versatile and food friendly."
