

## 2019 GREG NORMAN ESTATES MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC



### Review Summary

**91+ pts/VERY GOOD** “This pale straw-colored Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand opens with a pleasant nose of cut grass, lemon and white grapefruit. On the palate, it is light to medium bodied with well-balanced clean acidity and a creamy mouthfeel. It displays lovely flavors of citrus; lemon-lime and grapefruit. We also detected some mild and pleasant minerality mixed in. The finish fades away nicely. We would pair this very good value Sauvignon Blanc with sautéed shrimp over linguine with a creamy lemon garlic sauce.”
