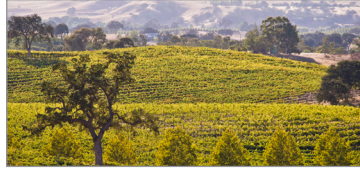


2019 GREG NORMAN ESTATES

PASO ROBLES CABERNET SAUVIGNON



WINEMAKER: Bill Nancarrow
REGION: Paso Robles, California
VARIETALS: Cabernet Sauvignon
MATURATION: 18 months in seasoned French oak
ALCOHOL: 13.6% alc/vol

REGION: Paso Robles is located between San Francisco and Los Angeles along California's Central Coast. The region enjoys a greater day-to-night temperature swing than any other major appellation in California. With many distinct microclimates, more than 45 different soil types and a long growing season, Paso Robles is well suited to producing a range of premium wines, in particular structured and juicy Cabernets.

WINEMAKING: After a gentle destemming process, the fruit was fermented for up to ten days in stainless-steel, open-top tanks and pumped over three times a day. The dry wine was then pressed off skins and transferred to seasoned French oak to mature before blending the individual Cabernet Sauvignon lots and bottling.

TASTING NOTES: Beautiful purple hue to start. Vibrant aromas of black fruit, dried violets, and cocoa dust. The palate shows purity and freshness. Dark fruits follow the nose onto the palate, along with baking spices, and toasted barrel notes. A richly flavored wine with an impressive structure for this price point.
