92 pts “This single vineyard Hunter Semillon from over-20-year-old vines still has many years ahead of it, but it’s also in a happy drinking spot now. The nose is open and expressive, with waxy lemon and lime, peach pit, white spice and gentle herbal aromas. The palate is zippy, fresh and fruity, softened by a supple texture and honeyed notes. A pithy lemony bite finishes.”

91 pts “Just beginning to show some aged aromas, the 2016 Oakey Creek Vineyard Semillon is a recent release that’s been timed perfectly. Aromas of crushed stone meet hints of toast, honey and preserved lemon in this light to medium-bodied wine. It’s still a bit austere and capable of going another five years or more, but it reveals future generosity on the finish, which is completely dry yet hints at stone fruit and marmalade.”
