VINTAGE NOTES: Coonawarra received good winter rains leading into the growing season. A cool and dry April was perfect for ripening, allowing full flavor development and optimal sugar levels. Yields of red wine grapes were between average to slightly below the long-term average.

WINEMAKING: Sourced from older vines on the estate, Tolmer has a more textural tannin profile. In the cellar, small lots are vinified separately utilizing only natural yeast to offer many options for the final blend. Some lots will see extended maceration for up to 30 days to add texture and tannin. The wine is aged in French oak barrels for 12 months ( $30 \%$ new) before being blended in stainless steel to marry flavors prior to bottling.

TASTING NOTES: The Tolmer is a modern expression of Coonawarra cabernet showcasing intense blackcurrants and savoury notes of French oak. It's medium-bodied without being heavy and has a generous core of juicy fruits with well-integrated chalky tannins. The seamless finish rounds off a bright, fragrant wine that can be enjoyed now or cellared for a few more years.
