

2019 GREG NORMAN ESTATES SANTA BARBARA PINOT NOIR



WINEMAKER: Bill Nancarrow
REGION: Santa Barbara County, California
VARIETALS: Pinot Noir
MATURATION: 12 months in seasoned French oak and stainless steel
ALCOHOL: 14.0% alc/vol

REGION: Santa Barbara County enjoys a long growing season, perfect for the development of concentrated and balanced fruit. The coastal climate is key – it is just warm enough that the fruit fully ripens, yet not too hot that vegetal undertones appear. The well-draining sandstone and limestone soils consistently produce small berries that are richly concentrated. The majority of the fruit for this wine was sourced from hillside vineyards in the cooler end of the North Canyon.

WINEMAKING: After a gentle destemming process, the whole berries were fermented in stainless-steel, open-top tanks and punched down daily. A portion of the wine gained complexity with time in French oak. The remainder of the blend was aged in stainless steel to preserve the fresh fruit flavors and maintain a good acid structure to the finished wine.

TASTING NOTES: This Santa Barbara Pinot Noir shines with fresh raspberries, cola and cherry liqueur. The palate is silky and the acidity youthful. Fresh plum, cherry and licorice carry lightly toasted oak spices through the long finish. A clean, balanced style Pinot Noir.
