### Review Summary



**91 pts** “Vivid straw. Bright, pure and incisive on the perfumed nose, displaying an array of citrus and orchard fruit qualities and a suave floral overtone. Dry and sharply delineated on the palate, offering nervy lemon zest, green apple and bitter quinine flavors that slowly deepen on the back half. Shows a juicy honeydew melon quality on the clinging finish, which is braced by a spicy jolt of ginger.”

**90 pts** “An intensely varietal bouquet, predominantly in the gooseberry/snow pea spectrum, but with elements of ripe tropical fruit in the background. A small percentage was fermented in aged French oak which has contributed to the mouthfeel, as does a touch of sweetness. It’s perhaps not as zippy through the palate as some releases, but it’s fresh and flavoursome.”
