94 pts “Glistening ruby. Expansive, spice- and mineral-accented cherry, mulberry and potpourri scents pick up a hint of smokiness as the wine opens up. Sappy, well-concentrated red and blue fruit and lavender pastille flavors show surprising vivacity for their left. Smooth, polished tannins emerge slowly on a very long, penetrating finish that emphatically repeats the floral and mineral notes.”
