90 pts “Clare Valley’s comparatively cool climate is on show in this Shiraz. Make no mistake, it’s still a ripe, full-figured wine, but there’s added spice and refreshment. Brambly blackberries and blueberries combine with notes of mocha, wintery spice, sap and other woody notes nuances. The palate is powerful yet balanced with quite a prominent line of chalky, spicy tannins and lifted acidity. Give this time in decanter if drinking now, and plenty of protein, too.”
