### Review Summary



**92 pts** “Lush and forward in its red berry scent, this pinot is leavened by a spicy whole-cluster note of bergamot and black tea. The plump flavors come together as the wine turns juicy and lively, with tangy acids and an irresistible succulence—a textural resistance for a mushroom and chard pasta.”
