91 pts “This is a big, broody wine with massive tannins. The fruit is there in the form of ripe cherry and plum and there are lovely spice notes such as ground pepper, bay leaf and allspice. An underlay of mocha oak is present, too. The palate is particularly austere due to dusty, savory tannins, but an intriguing texture and some plump fruit balance it out.”
