

2020 LEEUWIN ESTATE SIBLINGS SAUVIGNON BLANC

Review Summary



92 pts “100% sauvignon blanc. 10-15% barrel ferment, initial vigorous lees stirring to build texture. Lower yields in ‘20 reduced the production quantity of this wine. This has a super-grassy and herbal nose, with white pepper and spice. The palate is laced with blackcurrant and lychee, shaped by creamy, fine phenolic grip through the mid palate. Pretty, aromatic and lithe... epic value for money.”

91 pts “Pale, green-tinged straw. Fresh citrus and orchard fruit scents are complemented by hints of bay leaf and fennel. Chewy and tightly focused on the palate, offering bitter lime zest, pear skin and quinine flavors and a deeper suggestion of honeydew melon. Finishes on a spicy note, with building florality and a late snap of chalky minerality.”
