94 pts "The 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon (Spring Mountain District) is packed with dark cherry, plum, mocha, spice, new leather and chocolate. This racy, exuberant Cabernet offers tons of immediacy and up-front appeal, certainly more than most 2019s. There's plenty of depth, not to mention tons of personality. The Spring Mountain Cabernet will benefit from a few years in bottle, which will help soften the tannins."

93+ pts "Gentle sage and bay leaf shadings accent the black cherry fruit on the nose of the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Spring Mountain District. It's a firm, gently chewy effort, with masses of ripe tannins, a rich, velvety texture and a lingering, "furry" finish. The fruit has pretty much soaked up all of the 90% new French oak thrown at it."
