94 pts “57/43% Kayena/Hazards vineyards; fermented in 26% new French oak barrels. Resolution represents fantastic value, and a big step up from the entry-level Devil's Corner repertoire. Tamar and East Coast Tasmania unite here with impressive precision of grapefruit and white peach, nicely contrasting with the cashew of French oak. It will appreciate a year or 2 to find its feet. Tasmanian acidity lays out a bright, long, mineral finish that promises medium-term endurance.”
