

2019 PENLEY ESTATE

STEYNING CABERNET SAUVIGNON



WINEMAKER: Kate Goodman
REGION: Coonawarra, South Australia
VARIETALS: Cabernet Sauvignon
MATURATION: 50% matured in large format french oak foudre, 25% in new french oak barrels & remaining 25% in seasoned French oak barrels
ANALYSIS: 14.5% alc/vol | 6.5 g/L TA

VINTAGE: Wet conditions following the end of the 2017 vintage carried on through winter and spring with above average rainfall for the start of the 2018 season. In the Penley Estate vineyards steps were taken to ensure optimum canopies for the conditions. Shoot thinning was employed to improve canopy microclimate where necessary. Existing populations of native grasses and cover crops were left to grow to compete with vines for moisture, restricting vine growth and keeping shoots from growing beyond ideal length and density.

TASTING NOTES: Concentrated aromas of black olive, cassis, mulberry leather and dark chocolate. The densely concentrated fruit is supported by cedar notes from the French oak. A wine of complexity and length bolstered by brooding savory tannins. Drinking fantastically now and will age gracefully well into the future. An excellent example of Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon.
