92 pts "Fresh and light, but not shy on intensity. A touch of toasted sesame seed, fresh grated ginger and salted melon flavors add complexity to the core of citrus and ripe stone fruit flavors. Vibrant, mouthwatering acidity weaves in and out, highlighting all the details."
