96 pts “The 2018 is deep purple in color, with an inviting nose of briar, ink, crushed blackcurrants and black plums, lightly-veneered in cedary oak. It’s medium-bodied with a superfine mouth-feel and great intensity of dark fruit flavors, perhaps with a hint of anise. Lip-smacking balance and easy drying tannins carry an ultra-long finish. Superb.”

It opens with a high-toned bouquet of raspberry, blueberry and strawberry underscored by cedar, eucalyptus and sumac spice along with subtle but present chocolatey oak. The spicy, juicy-fruited palate shows lovely freshness, balance and pose, retaining a linearity that’s nicely supported by textural tannins and oak.”
