17/20 pts “Pale shell pink. Ineffably elegant. There’s a brush of early-summer scent, of hedgerow flowers, of the smell of a hay meadow when the grasses are long and heavy with florets. Archingly [sic] dry and yet the curve presses into plenty of fruit – this is not a bony wine. It has folds of mandolin-thin stone fruit and fine-cotton texture. And there is, as the back label suggests a touch of tomato and bay leaf, but also a touch of the delicate green-leaf-licorice of fresh basil. Begging for summer food al fresco, the crunch of raw veg, the bite of olive oil and the sweetness of seafood.”

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
